

DriveTest Day Checklist

For an Indian Class G applicant preparing for Ontario's non-reciprocal foreign-licence process. Check the current official requirements before your visit.

IDENTITY AND STATUS

- ☐ Original acceptable identification showing legal name and complete date of birth
- ☐ Valid Canadian immigration/status document, if required for my application
- ☐ Evidence linking name differences across passport, licence or immigration records

INDIAN LICENCE

- ☐ Original, valid Indian driver's licence
- ☐ Licence number, class, status and expiry date are legible
- ☐ I have not relied on a photo, ordinary photocopy or phone screenshot as a replacement

LICENSING HISTORY

- ☐ Authentication or licensing-history document issued within the last six months
- ☐ Issued by an authorized licensing authority, consulate, embassy or High Commission
- ☐ Shows official letterhead, logo, emblem or coat of arms
- ☐ Shows date first licensed, licence class, status and expiry date
- ☐ Shows my full name and identifying information

LANGUAGE AND TRANSLATION

- ☐ Licence and supporting records are in English or French
- ☐ If not, translation was completed by an MTO-recognized translator
- ☐ I will bring the original document together with its translation

VISIT PREPARATION

- ☐ Glasses or contact lenses needed for the vision test
- ☐ Accepted payment method
- ☐ G1 knowledge-test preparation completed
- ☐ DriveTest centre address and current hours checked

ASK DRIVETEST TO CONFIRM

- ☐ How many months of foreign experience were accepted?
- ☐ What is my earliest possible G2 road-test date?
- ☐ Which tests must I complete?
- ☐ Is any additional document or translation required?
